The RM team is consisting of five ambitious colleagues that are tasked to mobilize substantial resources and building strategic partnerships around our digital health agenda for Africa. The team is developing strategic partnerships with corporates, bilateral, multilateral institutions and private donors.

As Grants Proposal Writer you will be responsible for the creation of funding applications and pitches both in Word and PowerPoint. In this process you will work closely with business developers, business leads, colleagues at the PharmAccess country offices and the data and analytics team. Since you have excellent analytical skills and understanding of the healthcare sector in low- and middle-income countries, you are an important sparring partner to our colleagues in designing proposals. Besides all this, you love of course writing.

Key tasks include:

- Market analysis
- Prepare and write high scoring proposals with a multi-disciplinary team, including theory of changes, KPI frameworks, risk registers and budgets
- Meet proposal deadlines by coordinating the proposal development and review process
- Prepare appealing presentations and pitches in PowerPoint
- Improve professionalization of the resource mobilization team by developing and updating templates, boiler plates, case studies, biography information as well as starting a repository of key data
- Capture key lessons learned from our interventions
- Editing donor reports
